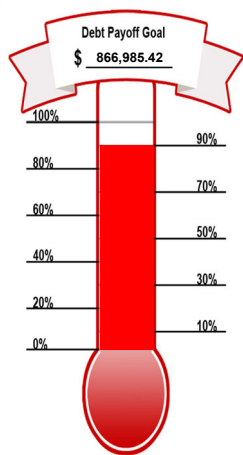

## EMERGENCY DIOCESAN DIRECTIVES

Effective immediately until  
February 22th, 2021

- Close ALL parish offices, allowing bare minimum of critical staff only, to work on-site, and only for tasks that cannot be completed remotely.
- Cancel ALL in-person meetings of ANY type and of ANY number (parish staff; clergy/deacons; all parish committees; all training sessions), including meetings of ministry services, ministry programs, etc. The permission for meetings of up to ten (10) persons is rescinded and prohibited until further notice. You should conduct any and all types of meetings by ZOOM or other remote technologies.
- Conduct all parish business, ministry coordination remotely — via Zoom or other remote communication.

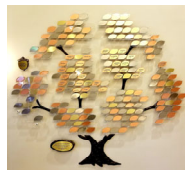
